Progress this year

Local teams in Fife and Dundee are continuing their marketing & awareness activities. The focus has been on getting the word out to SMEs through holding employer engagement events and advertising in a variety of places from petrol pumps to ice rinks and football stadiums. Work to set up a portal to allow Jobcentre Plus staff to refer directly to the service continues. GPs continue to be the largest referrers and plans are underway to increase the engagement of this important group. We are delighted the figures show a steady increase in referrals overall. Last but not least, the first phase of evaluation has been awarded to Rocket Science. We look forward to the initial findings!

Published Data

Published data shows there were 544 enrolments from June to December 2018. The most common health condition was musculoskeletal (63% of referrals) followed by mental health conditions (25% of referrals). 86% of people enrolled into case management were employed.
