

## 2025/26 Scottish Government Allocations for No One Left Behind by Local Authority

No One Left Behind is an approach which ensures employment support is person-centred, tailored and responsive to the needs of local labour markets and individuals of all ages who are looking for help to find and remain in work.

The information provided in the table below sets out the distribution of Scottish Government funding allocations in 2025/26 for No One Left Behind by Local Authority Area.

The values displayed do not reflect any additional local funding that local authorities contribute to support local employability services.

It should be noted that figures in this table may be marginally different from final allocations due to rounding.

Funding is intended to ensure an enhanced offer of support for disabled people and people with long term health conditions is in place in every local authority area. This may be used to scale existing provision where it is already in place.
