

## 2023/24 Scottish Government Allocations for No One Left Behind by Local Authority

No One Left Behind is an approach which ensures employment support is person-centred, tailored and responsive to the needs of local labour markets and individuals of all ages who are looking for help to find and remain in work.

The information provided in the table sets out the distribution of Scottish Government funding allocations in 2023/24 for No One Left Behind by Local Authority Area.

The values displayed do not reflect any additional local funding that local authorities contribute to support local employability services.
